 - Drawing for prizes will be in reverse order with the first ticket drawn as the 15th prize and so forth
 - After prizes 2-15 are drawn, all tickets will be returned to the "hat" for the Grand Prize Drawing

 - \$20.00 Price for each ticket
 - Proceeds from raffle ticket sales will benefit the CASL Scholarship Fund to support CASL players in need of financial assistance.  - ECNL players to sell 5 tickets each
