Some highlights include the HEART program which offers weekly soccer practices and games to youth with intellectual disabilities, the Friendship Cup allows community teams to be formed and play a single-day tournament at no cost to families or teams, and collaborations with local community centers (e.g., Peach Road, Method Road) to provide positive after-school outlets for youth.
